

## TRAVEL GUIDE – practical advice, recommendations etc.

We understand that planning your journey may feel a bit overwhelming — but don’t worry, we’ve got you covered! Below, you’ll find practical travel advice and recommendations to help make your trip as smooth as possible.

### Arriving in Denmark by plane

Traveling to the KLAP Theatre Festival is easy with several convenient airport options in Denmark. Below are our recommended routes to help you plan your journey to Kolding:

- **Copenhagen Airport (CPH):** As Denmark’s primary international airport, Copenhagen Airport is well-connected to major cities across the world. From here, you can travel to Kolding by train, bus or domestic flight.  
We highly recommend taking the train, as it offers a scenic and comfortable journey through Denmark. The trip from Copenhagen Airport to Kolding takes approximately 2 hours and 45 minutes, with frequent departures throughout the day.
- **Billund Airport (BLL):** Located closer to Kolding, Billund Airport is an excellent alternative, offering flights from many European cities. While there is no direct train connection from Billund, reaching Kolding remains easy and convenient.  
You can take a direct bus from Billund Airport to Kolding, with a travel time of approximately 1 hour and 15 minutes. The journey offers beautiful views of the Danish countryside. Alternatively, you can opt for a bus and train combination, which provides more frequent departure options to suit your schedule.

### Arriving in Denmark by train

Denmark’s extensive and efficient train network offers a comfortable way to reach Kolding from major cities both within Denmark and across Europe.

- **From Copenhagen**  
The journey from Copenhagen Central Station to Kolding is comfortable and scenic, taking approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes. Trains run frequently throughout the day, ensuring flexibility for your travel plans.
- 



- **From Hamburg**

For travelers arriving from other parts of Europe, Hamburg in Germany is an ideal gateway. There are direct train services from Hamburg to Kolding, making the trip straightforward and hassle-free. The journey takes approximately 2 hours and 50 minutes, with several daily departures, providing flexibility and ease.

### **Journey Planner – schedules and tickets for local public transportation**

To plan your trip to Kolding, we recommend using the [Journey Planner](#). This easy-to-use tool helps you find the best travel connections by train, bus or a combination of both, tailored to your schedule and preferences.

Once you've found your ideal route, you can send the itinerary directly to your email to keep the details at hand. The platform also allows you to purchase tickets quickly and securely. For a smooth experience, remember to select the 'single ticket' option when booking your journey.

We encourage you to plan your trip in advance to secure the best connections and fares, ensuring a smooth and enjoyable journey to Kolding.

### **Time of arrival and departure**

To make the most of your time at the KLAP Theatre Festival, we recommend planning your arrival in the morning and scheduling your departure in the late afternoon or early evening.

Please be aware that public transportation services do not operate around the clock, so it's important to plan your journey accordingly. We encourage you to use the [Journey Planner](#) to find the most efficient travel options and ensure you don't miss any part of the festival programme.


### **Accommodation**

Kolding offers a variety of accommodation options, ranging from cosy bed and breakfasts to high-end hotels. We recommend booking your stay well in advance, as the festival period typically attracts a large number of visitors.

For maximum convenience, we encourage you to consider a delegate package that includes accommodation at Hotel Saxildhus. This package features a standard single room with breakfast, ensuring a comfortable stay throughout the festival. 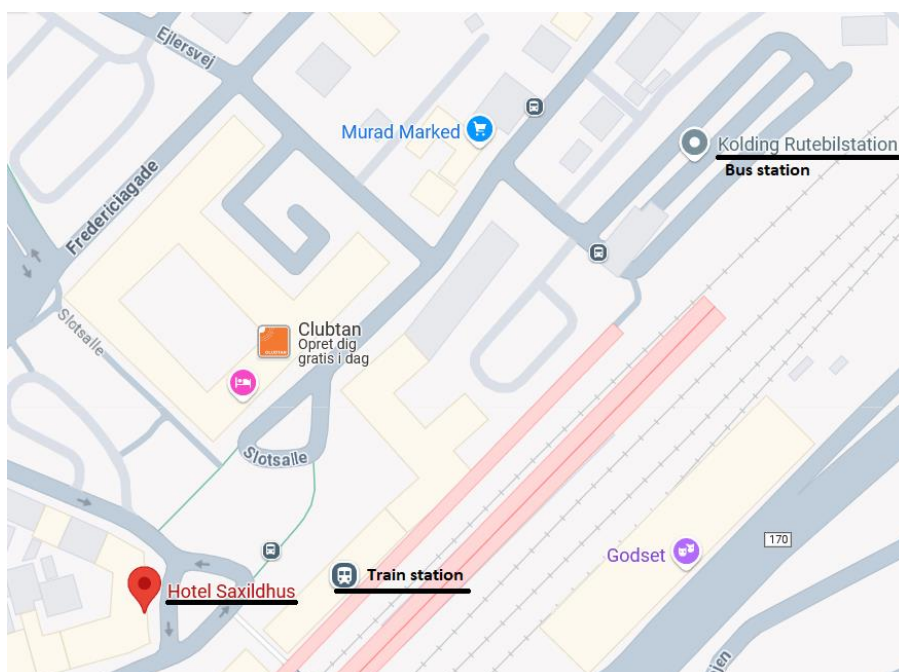


Hotel Saxildhus is ideally located in the heart of Kolding, just steps away from both the train station and bus station, providing easy access to and from the festival.
